At This Time in Our Family History

- **Aug. 1, 1876**—Cipriana Maldonado died in Guayanilla, P.R. She was the paternal grandmother of Florencio Rivera.
- Aug. 4, 1710—Lope Maldonado de León and Juana de los Reyes Orozco were married in Arecibo, Puerto Rico. If you count Florencio Rivera Maldonado as your ancestor, then you are a direct descendent of Lope Maldonado and Juana de los Reyes Orozco.
- Aug. 8, 1916—Anita Rivera (Merritt) was born in Peñuelas, Puerto Rico. She was the youngest child of Florencio Rivera and Ana Cruz García.
- Aug. 9, 1872—Florencio Rivera was born in Guayanilla, Puerto Rico
- **Aug. 9, 1821**—José de la Cruz García, maternal great-grandfather of Adela, Oscar, María, Elena, Guar, and Aníta, was born in
- Aug. 19, 1855—Engracia García, mother of Ana Cruz García, was born in Peñuelas.
- Aug. 16, 1916—Ana Cruz García, wife of Florencio Rivera, passed away in Peñuelas, P.R., leaving six motherless children: Adela, Oscar, María, Elena, Guar, and Anita.
- Aug. 17, 1904—Carmela Cruz was born in Peñuelas, Puerto Rico. She was a daughter of Máximo Cruz and Genara Maldonado. She was the grandmother of Annie Meléndez, who hosted the 2009 family reunion in Peñuelas, and of the Felicianos, who hosted the 2010 family reunion in Chicago. Carmela died in Sept. of 1998.
- **Sept. 6, 1991**—Ana López Maldonado, wife of Oscar Cruz García, passed away in Ponce, Puerto Ríco
- **Sept. 7, 1878**—María Inés Vílá died in Peñuelas at the age of 58. She was a great-grandmother of Matilde, Adela, Oscar, María, Elena, Guar, and Anita.
- **Sept. 11, 1917** Vicente Neri Rivera, oldest son of Florencio Rivera and Otilia Pacheco, passed away in Ponce, at 55 years of age.
- **Sept. 23, 1908**—Matilde Cruz, daughter of Ana Cruz García, died in Peñuelas at less than 20 months of age. It is unknown if she was a daughter of Florencio Rivera.
- Sept. 30, 1887—Petronila Chavarría, maternal great-grandmother of Nerí, Isidro, Títa, and Delía, died in Peñuelas.

A Page Out of Our Family History

While updating my Family Tree Maker program with information given by cousins René, Titi, Papo, Ada, and Lilliam on my recent trip to Puerto Rico, I questioned the four year gap between Lilliam's birth and Luz's.

"Did your parents lose a child in between Lilliam and Luz?" I asked, thinking that maybe there was a miscarriage or a stillbirth.

"Oh, yes," they replied, "Reinaldo."

"What?! He had a name? It wasn't a miscarriage?"

I was told that there was a little boy who died at about the age of three. René said he used to take care of him, and remembered that he was about 11 years old when his little brother died of a bad case of intestinal worms, vomiting and diarrhea. How devastating this must have been for the Rivera family! I was so surprised that NO ONE had ever told me about this before, and probably wouldn't have said anything if I hadn't asked. Not my dad, nor any of my aunts or uncles, and most surprisingly, none of Reinaldo's siblings. By the next morning, I had located his death record on www.familysearch.com.

Little Reinaldo is now listed in his proper place in the family tree, surrounded by the other children of Guar and Elena. He was born on Jan. 14, 1946 in Ponce, Puerto Rico, and died on Aug. 18, 1949, also in Ponce.
