

Petronila was one of Otilia Pacheco's sisters, so María's husband's family is all related to the descendents of Otilia (i.e., to Uncle Isidro, Tía Tita, Tía Delia and their descendents). She said that Angelina Feliciano Pacheco, one of Petronila's daughters, and hence a first cousin to Isidro, Tita and Delia, lives in Waterbury (Connecticut?). Santos died in 1996. 
Shanda and Robert King's Wedding Album

Shanda, Robert and Kali. ♥
































y la familia, the Human Genome Project and 23andMe

Just to think that not more than 20 years ago, scientists worked on a monumental project - deciphering the human genome. All of that work, conducted by a collaboration of many scientists in many countries was completed with the announcement that the human genome had been sequenced in October 2004. I am interested in science and discoveries like this fascinate me.

So, what does this all mean to you? It is possible now, today!, to submit a saliva sample to a company, (23andme.com), and receive detailed information in 3-4 weeks about your health risks, inherited conditions and traits, health tools, ancestral composition, maternal line for females and paternal line information for males and females. Inherited condition markers indicate your chances (above or below average) for diseases such as breast cancer, prostate cancer, Alzheimer's and 250 other inherited conditions.

How does this affect our family? Collectively, the information gathered adds to the family ancestral map. Individual test results are private and confidential. Results, some or all, may be shared with close family if you choose. Personally, my wife Barbara and I, son Christopher and his wife, Cindy had the test done and we are in the registry. I can share a tiny bit of what I learned. I am at a decreased risk for prostate cancer but have an increased risk for gall bladder issues. Additionally, LOL, I'm 2.8% Neanderthal.

Not many years ago, genetic testing cost thousands of dollars to have done. Today, 23andme is \$100, certainly not inexpensive but, in my opinion, well worth the expense.

Go to the website and see if it's a fit for you. If you sign up, your ancestral information will be added to our/your families' body of information.




Banyon Tree Park, looking toward Lahaina
